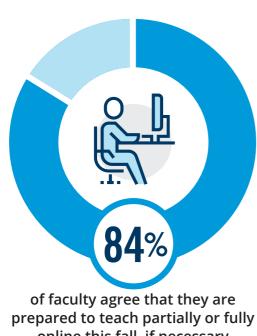

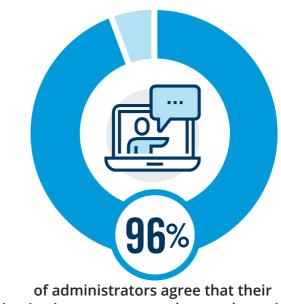


Moving Instruction Online—Ready or Not?
