







Enrollment Concerns

ALMOST EVERYONE IS CONCERNED ABOUT ENROLLMENTS




GREATEST CONCERN AT TWO-YEAR INSTITUTIONS





CONCERN STILL CRITICAL, BUT DIMINISHING

















The Impact of Al

EVERYONE EXPECTS AI TO CHANGE THEIR INSTITUTION






What areas of your institution do you expect AI to change?




Poll: Do you think your institution is ready for AI-related changes?

Respondents at four year schools believe they are more prepared than two year ones














Student Stress

To what degree are feelings of stress a problem for you?




Students cite stress as their most pressing barrier, with a major reporting that they are suffering a "Great deal of stress."

A third of students are unaware of any institutional supports.

Forty percent are aware but chose not to use the supports.

The small portion using the services generally find them to be effective.
